Rob Roy, son of Ryan offers a genetic outcross as he comes from the Romulus bloodline, an earlier excellent Furzeland sire.

Rob Roy had a magnificent 2yr head, a stand out in very good company. His style of antlers is the type of which we believe the trophy industry requires. Large round beam with excellent length in lower tynes and a long overall aspect with multiple high scoring tops.

After a serious foot problem in 2007 which affected his 4 year old antler Rob Roy has made great improvement and produced excellent 5 and 6 year old heads.

Rob Roy's 6 year antlers were measured by Duncan Fraser at the 2010 South Canterbury Velvet & HA Competition to be 499^{MI}. With his spread and burrs this has reassessed his head at 547^{MI}.

This stag we believe is potentially one of the best sires we have ever bred.
